Warm Up What is some of the best news you have ever received?

Digging Deeper

Read Romans 10:1-4

Why does Paul have such strong feelings for the Israelite people?

Read Romans 10:5-13

How would your life look different if righteousness came by works?

How does the truth of "righteousness that is by faith" impact the way you live?

Paul speaks to the closeness of Christ, and that it is unnecessary to go to extremes to find and experience relationship with him. Do you believe this to be true, or do you find yourself searching to find God in a lot of different places? If you find yourself looking for God in different places, what places might those be?

How might a true belief in the fact that God came for all who call on him, impact the way we live our lives and share the truth of the Gospel?

Read Romans 10:14-15

Paul makes very clear the importance of sharing the gospel. Do you feel that same importance? Why or why not?

Read Romans 10:16-21

Although Israel heard the "message," they were still resistant. However, as verse 21 points out, God continues to reach out to them. What does this demonstrate about the nature/character of God?

What would it look like for you to be more intentional about sharing the gospel with others, either at home, in your neighborhood, at work, etc.?

How has God been making himself known to you lately through scripture?
